## **One Investment Program**

With the introduction of Bill 68 comes changes to the *Municipal Act*, including municipal investments. Join ONE Staff as we highlight what the Prudent Investor Standard means for your municipality, how you can leverage the investment returns in substitution of tax dollars to finance your municipality's Asset Management Plan (AMP), as well as provide you with more details of what ONE Investment is doing to help Ontario Municipalities access the new investment option.

## **Roads Assessment Service**

Roughly 1/3 of Ontario's roads are in poor to very poor condition and maintaining them chews up a large portion of a municipal budget. This innovative service assists with asset management, capital planning and maintenance decisions related to one of the most important municipal assets – roads! We will also introduce our new **sidewalk assessment service**.

## **Recreation Facility Lighting Service**

Don't be fooled by the title, this program includes arenas, pools, community centres, as well as transit and public works garages. Any facility with "high-bay lighting" qualifies. Discover the energy and cost saving opportunities available to municipalities looking to upgrade their facility lighting. We will provide an overview for planned expansion of this program.

## **Sewer & Water Line Warranty Service**

Every year municipalities are inundated with calls about sewer and water lateral failures that are actually the responsibility of the homeowner. Learn how you can provide the residents in your municipality with a low cost warranty option to cover these unexpected repairs.
